<b>Missions Fund</b> <i>[For general mission expense as determined by the Session]</i>	(Always)
<b>Donegal Food Ministry</b> <i>[For support of the Donegal Church Food distribution, and of local area food banks]</i>	(Always)
<b>Memorial Fund</b> <i>[For donations made in memory of church members and their families]</i>	(Always)
<b>Endowment Fund</b> <i>[For donations to grow the principle of the fund that will generate expendable income]</i>	(Always)
<b>PW Mission Pledge</b> <i>[For donations By the women of Donegal Church]</i>	(Always)
<b>“Closing the Gap” Mortgage Fund</b> <i>[Donations to pay off the mortgage faster than the current 10-year schedule]</i>	(until paid off)
<b>Per Capita and Initial Offering</b> <i>[For members to pay their “fair share” of the General Assembly per capita assessment]</i>	(January 1 to Ash Wednesday)
<b>One Great Hour of Sharing</b> <i>[100% of contributions go to disaster relief and the Presbyterian Hunger program]</i>	(Ash Wednesday to Easter)
<b>Deacons Offering</b> <i>[100% used locally to support those in need in Donegal Church and the local community]</i>	(May 1 to July 31)
<b>Peace Offering</b> <i>[25% to Donegal’s global witness; 25% to Presbytery, 50% to Presbyterian Mission Agency]</i>	(August 1 to October 31)
<b>Christmas Joy Offering</b> <i>[50% to retired church workers; 50% for scholarships for church leaders in communities of color]</i>	(November 1 to December 31)
